**Milbemax** treats all existing tapeworms in a patient but do not prevent re-infection through hunting. Indoor/outdoor **hunting cats** need to be de-wormed for tapeworm **once a month** at the same time as Advantage. Indoor cats require treatment annually. These worms can be hazardous to human health.
