3. TAPEWORMS

How often? - Once a year
(or more often see note # 1)

NOTE#1: Tapeworms are transmitted by fleas, and by the ingestion of mice, voles, bunnies, carcasses, earthworms and other small outdoor creatures. For hunting/roaming dogs, once a month de-worming is recommended for Tapeworms as they can be hazardous to humans. Visit www.petsandparasites.org for more info.

NOTE#2: If you are traveling off the island, your dog will be susceptible to contracting heartworm disease through mosquito bites. To avoid infection give Interceptor once every month.

NOTE#3: DO NOT GIVE Advantix TO CATS.

NOTE#4: Households with persons who are immune compromised need to de-worm and de-flea once a month year round.
